NCC Annual Training Camp -

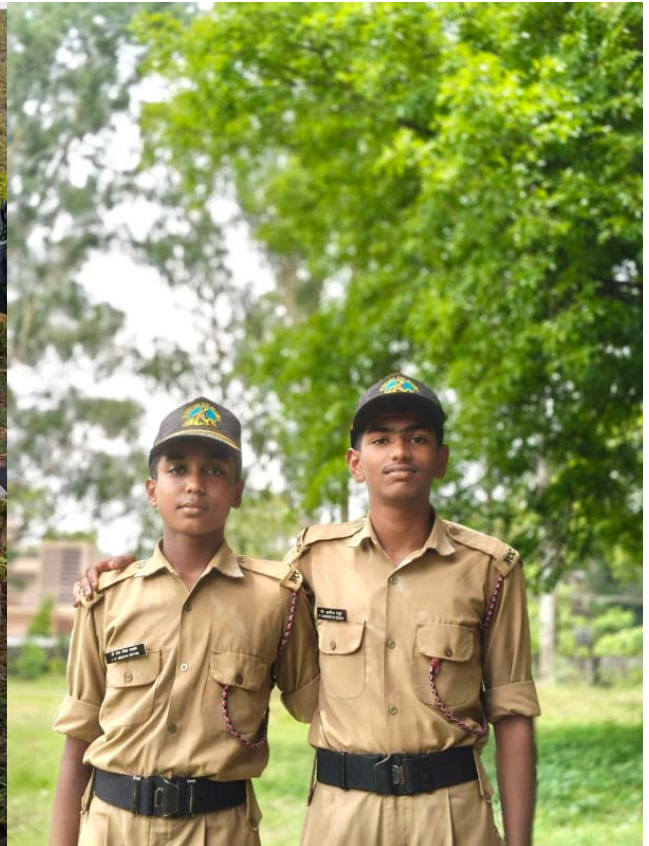
The Annual Training Camp (ATC–VI) was successfully conducted at Nallamalla Reddy School from 03 May 2026 to 12 May 2026.

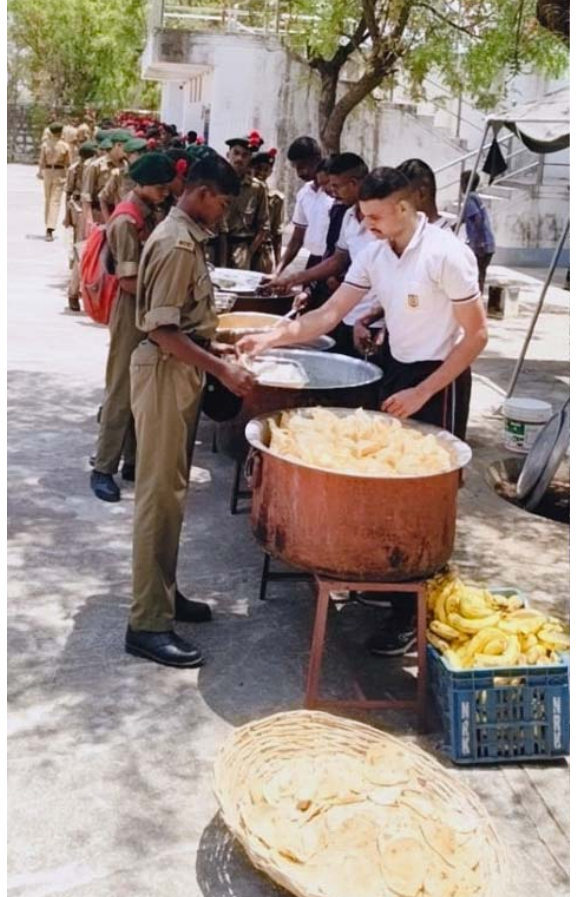


NCC CAMP & EVENTS: Annual Training Camp – 2026
